5. Consensus seemed to be Mustangs should be judged under MCA rules, and judge sheets. The Fords would be judged similar to the Havelock show.

As a conclusion, a motion will be made at the January 8th meeting for membership consideration, approval and support to hold a spring Ford Mustang car show, appoint a committee chair and get things moving.
